



Hey! You there, yes you! This winter have you been interested into a scrumptious fall recipe? Well, in this following fall food recipe you shall find one of the most uniquest that you should most definitely try out this winter!



INGREDIENTS

- 23/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 cup unsalted butter, softened
- 11/2 cups granulated sugar
- 1 large egg
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1/2 teaspoon almond extract (optional)
- 1/4 cup buttermilk (or milk)

Enjoy your homemade sugar cookies! With your family and friends during the cold winters



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Preheat your oven to 375°F (190°C) and line baking sheets with parchment paper.
- 2. In a medium bowl, whisk together the flour, baking soda, and baking powder. Set aside.
- 3. In a large mixing bowl, cream together the softened butter and sugar until light and fluffy.
 4. Add the egg, vanilla extract, and almond extract (if using). Mix until well combined.
- 5. Gradually add the dry ingredients to the wet ingredients, mixing just until the dough comes together. If the dough seems too dry, you can add buttermilk (or regular milk) a little at a time until it reaches the right consistency.
- 6. Divide the dough into two equal portions, flatten each into a disk, wrap in plastic wrap, and chill in the refrigerator for at least 1 hour.
- 7. On a floured surface, roll out the chilled dough to about 1/4-inch thickness. Use cookie cutters to cut out desired shapes.
- 8. Place the cut-out cookies on the prepared baking sheets, leaving some space between each.
- 9. Bake for 8-10 minutes, or until the edges are lightly golden. Be careful not to overbake for a softer cookie.
- 10. Allow the cookies to cool on the baking sheets for a few minutes before transferring them to a wire rack to cool completely.
- 11. Once the cookies are cooled, you can decorate them with icing, sprinkles, or enjoy them as is.
