## MISSION STATEMENT

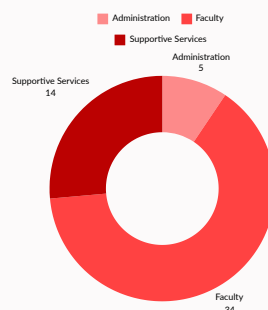
